How to obtain a Special (Exit) Pass after the Amnesty Program?

With the expiration of Malaysia's amnesty (3+1) program, the following are the requirements for the issuance of the special (exit) pass by the Malaysian Immigration Department:

1. Valid Passport/ Travel Document;
2. Police Report (in case of lost passport);
3. Filled up Immigration Intake Form;
4. Letter addressed to the Immigration signed by the applicant stating the reason/s or events, in chronological order, which caused him/her to overstay
5. Personal appearance at the immigration office; and
6. Other documents that may be required by the immigration office.

Upon submission of requirements, an investigation period (which generally takes 14 days) will follow. Then, the compound penalty is assessed. The compound penalty may range from RM 1,000 to 3,000, while the fee for the special pass is RM 100. The special (exit) pass is issued upon payment of the prescribed compound penalty and presentation of a confirmed ticket. The pass is valid for 14 days from date of issuance.

The Embassy also reminds Filipinos in Malaysia that, in certain cases, the Malaysian Immigration Department may deny the issuance of the special (exit) pass and proceed with the filing of legal charges in court, which may result in detention.

Malaysian immigration authorities have warned that applicants who are unable to present proof of entry to Malaysia may be denied the exit pass and charged in court.

ABISO MULA SA EMBAHADA NG PILIPINAS

PAANO KUMUHA NG SPECIAL (EXIT) PASS?

Simula nang nagtapos ang Amnesty (3+1) Program ng Malaysia, ang mga sumusunod ang kinakailangan sa pag-aapply para sa Special (Exit) Pass sa Malaysian Immigration Department:

1. Valid Passport/ Travel Document;
2. Police Report (para sa mga kaso ng 'lost passport');
3. Immigration Intake Form;
4. Sulat na naka-address sa Immigration Office, na may lagda ng aplikante, na nagpapaliwanag ng mga dahilan o mga pangyayari na nagdulot nang pag-overstay sa Malaysia
5. Personal na pag-sumite sa immigration office; at
6. Ibang dokumentong maaring hingin ng immigration office.

Matapos mag-sumite ng requirement, magsasagawa ang Immigration Department ng investigation na maaaring tumagal ng hanggang labing-apat na araw (14) araw. Matapos nito ay ipagbibigay alam ng Immigration Office kung magkano ang kaukulang compound penalty na dapat bayaran. Ang compound penalty ay maaaring umabot ng RM 1,000 to 3,000 at ang bayad para sa special pass ay RM 100. Ang special pass ay ini-issue matapos ang pagbabayad ng compound penalty at pagpapakita ng confirmed ticket pauwi nang Pilipinas. Ang exit pass ay valid hanggang labing-apat (14) na araw mula sa araw ng pag-isyu.

Ipinapaalala rin nang Embahada na may mga pagkakataong ang Malaysian Immigration Department ay maaaring mag-deny ng special pass, at sa halip ay magsampa ng kaso laban sa aplikante. Maaari itong humantong sa pagkakakulong (detention). Kabilang dito ang mga aplikante na hindi makakapagpakita ng "proof of entry" or entry visa sa Malaysia.

PENTING

Keperluan untuk Pas Keluar Khusus selepas Program Pengampunan

Menurut Jabatan Imigresen Malaysia, berikut adalah keperluan untuk permohonan Pas Keluar Khusus:

1. Pasport Sah / Dokumen Perjalanan;
2. Laporan Polis (sekiranya pasport hilang);
3. Borang Pengambilan Imigresen yang diisikan;
4. Surat yang dialamatkan kepada Imigresen yang ditandatangani oleh pemohon yang menyatakan sebab sebab kenapa tinggal lebih masa (Diabaikan peristiwa mesti diriwayatkan dalam urutan kronologi)
5. Penampilan peribadi (untuk penyerahan, data biometrik dan koleksi) ; dan
6. Dokumen dokumen lain yang mungkin diperlukan oleh Jabatan Imegresen.

Apabila mengemukakan syarat-syarat ini, tempoh penyiasatan yang secara amnya mengambil masa 14 hari akan diikuti, dan penalti kompaun dinilai. Selepas pembayaran

penalti yang ditetapkan dan pembentangan tiket yang disahkan, pas keluar khas akan dikeluarkan. Lulus sah selama 14 hari dari tarikh terbitan. Nota kedutaan bahawa Jabatan Imigresen Malaysia mempunyai budi bicara untuk menafikan pengeluaran

keluar pas dan untuk meneruskan tuntutan undang-undang di mahkamah, yang mungkin menyebabkan penjara

Imigresen Malaysia telah memberi amaran kepada pemohon yang tidak dapat mengemukakan bukti masuk ke Malaysia boleh dinafikan pas keluar dan akan dikenakan di mahkamah.
