Embassy's Transportation Assistance to Putrajaya for 3+1 Applicants

The Philippine Embassy in Kuala Lumpur wishes to inform Filipinos in Malaysia that in order to assist those who want to avail of Malaysia's Voluntary Deportation (3+1) Program which ends on August 30, the Embassy is providing **free transportation** from the Embassy to the Immigration Office in Putrajaya on the following dates:

August 13 (Monday)
August 15 (Wednesday)
August 20 (Monday)
August 23 (Thursday)
August 27 (Monday)

The Embassy is also assigning a Consular Officer to assist and accompany Filipino applicants to the Immigration Office on these dates. A maximum of 50 persons can be accommodated per day, and appointments will be made on a first come-first serve basis.

To sign up, please download and fill out the Transportation Service Appointment Form and send the accomplished form to klpetdteam@gmail.com. If the application is for a group or more than one person (e.g. family), please accomplish one form for every member of the group.

Click the link of the Transportation Service Appointment Form.

You will receive a confirmation message from the Embassy to confirm your appointment.

On the day of your appointment, please make sure to:

- be at the Embassy by 8:30 a.m.
- present the confirmation message to the Embassy guard upon entry
- bring the following to be submitted to the Immigration Office --
 - valid passport or travel document
 - RM 400 fee for the Exit Pass

You may also bring a snack or light refreshment in case of waiting periods at the Immigration Office.

Reminder: Please make sure that you have a confirmed ticket to the PH with the date of departure within five (5) days from the issuance of the exit pass.
